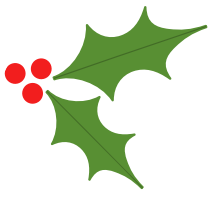

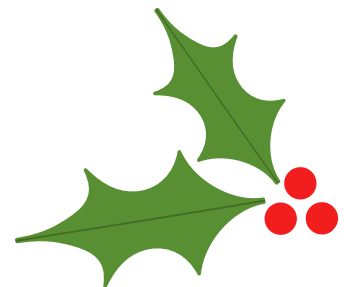
Hello there friends, I've dropped in for a short stay!
